BASIC LIFE SUPPORT FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS

The goal of the BLS for Healthcare Providers (American Heart Association accredited) Course is to train participants to save the lives of cardiac arrest victims through high-quality cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). The AHA designed the course to prepare healthcare professionals to know how to perform CPR in- and out-of-hospital settings. This course comprises of 36 modules and teaches the skills of CPR and Choking for victims of all ages, including ventilation with barrier devices, pocket masks, bag-valve-mask devices with supplemental oxygen, and the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AED).
